

## Grade 11 Post-Secondary Planning

School counselors will be working with juniors this semester to focus on their post-secondary research and planning. Below are important items to note:

Wednesday, December 9th: 11th graders will be asked to view [this lesson](#) and complete the next steps of their post-secondary planning. *Science teachers will be posting the lesson on Wednesday in their Google Classroom.*

- Complete Choosing A College lesson in Xello
- Work on their Post-Secondary High School Action Plan, share the document with their school counselor and parents/guardian before their Junior Conference
- Beginning the week of December 14th, juniors sign up for an individual, 40-minute Junior Conference with their school counselor (students click [here](#) to see how to book an appointment with their school counselor).
- During their Junior Conference, your student will be taking notes in their Post-Secondary High School Action Plan document and then uploading it into their Xello account. The Action Plan will include this [link](#) to our Junior Launchpad with additional resources and information to support their post-secondary planning.

School counselors facilitate Juniors Conferences well into the second semester so even though students are allowed to begin scheduling them the week of December 14th, they can choose a date after winter break and into the second semester.
